


Overview:

UltraQuest Reporter and Library requests can be scheduled for batch processing on a recurrent basis dependent on production or personal schedules. The UltraQuest Scheduler will submit your requests to batch for execution based on a user-specified frequency (every Friday, the last day of the month, etc.).

In addition, each site has the ability to define their own calendar, i.e. define what are their normal working days as well as holidays, which can affect when jobs are run. Users have the ability to decide what should happen if the job is scheduled for a non-working day.

Production

If a user wishes to schedule a request for batch processing as part of a production job, the user will be provided with the following dialog to complete.




There can be multiple jobs run, one for each application. These jobs may be run as part of the site's production process at the discretion of the site. Some sites may want to run these jobs after the production updates have completed for that day to ensure that all data will be current.

A third party scheduling package is used to manage running these jobs as part of the production process

Personal

If a user wishes to schedule a request for batch processing at a specified time, he would be provided with this dialog for completion.



The personal scheduler provides flexibility in scheduling when jobs are run and is not tied to production runs. For example, you would be able to schedule a job to run weekly on Monday and Friday at 08:00 AM.
